

Sodium hyaluronate is a visco-elastic polymer normally found in the aqueous and vitreous humour. HEALONID, which contains sodium hyaluronate is a and vitreous numoir. HEALDNID, which contains sodium hydiuronare is a highly viscous clear solution at rest, yet it will readily flow through a fine cannula or needle under pressure. Introduction of HEALDNID into the anterior or posterior chamber keeps tissues separated during the operative procedure and protects them from trauma from other tissues or instruments. The anterior chamber depth is maintained, vitreous bulge can be reduced, and the loss of irreplaceable endothelial cells which inevitably accompanies surgery can be greatly reduced. INDICATIONS

CONTRA-INDICATIONS, WARNINGS

There are no known contro-indications to HEALONID. Because the drug is extracted from avian tissues, despite rigorous purification procedures minute amounts of protein are present, and thus the remote possibility of idiosyncratic reactions remains.

ADVERSE REACTIONS

The drug is very well tolerated and the only untoward effect reported has been a transient rise in introocular pressure in a few cases.




