A-B: on FFA the CM presents an early focal hyperfluorescence, due to window defects, that in the late phases does not increase in intensity or width and shows staining. C-D: on ICGA the CM has an early lighting up and a serpiginous shape; in the later phases the fluorescence decreases and focal spots of hypofluorescence along the vessel become visible.
