A New Standard Trial Case



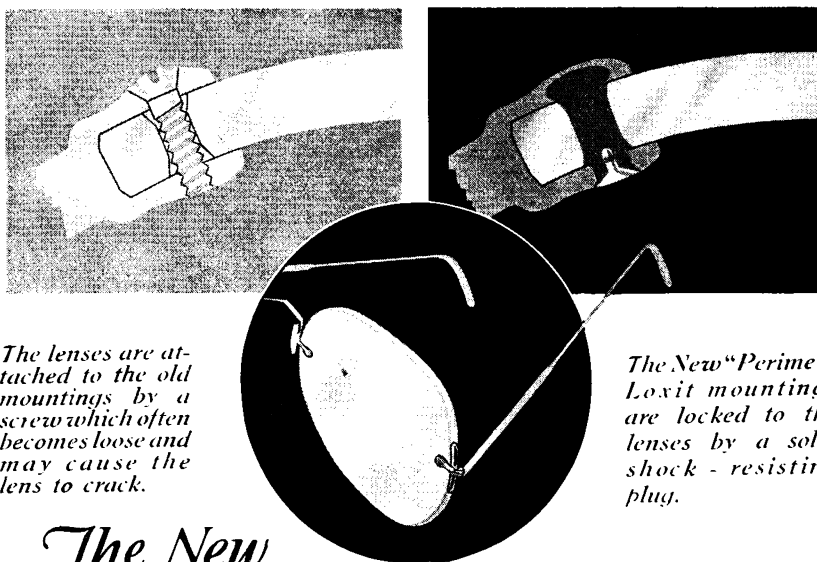
THE lenses are mounted in aluminium disc rings of special construction which provide a lens aperture of 20 m/m. They are secured by spinning into a special flanged groove and cannot become loose. The handles of the rims are not soldered on but part of the stamping and shaped for strength. The contour of the handles differentiates between convex and concave.

All lenses are Plano Convex and Plano Concave of minimum substance and guaranteed curves, and are of waxed polish finish. The Cylinders are plainly axis marked and all figures boldly engraved. The set contains 32 pairs each Convex and Concave Spheres 0.12 to 20 D., 19 pairs each Cylinders 0.12 to 6, 12 Prisms, 4 pairs Crookes' Tints, Cross line, frosted, stenopaic and pinhole discs, Maddox Rod, etc.

The action of opening the lid, automatically raises the tray to a suitable angle for use; the skeleton tray is removable for cleaning, and the casework which can be in Oak, Mahogany, Teak or Walnut is of very sound construction and superior finish.

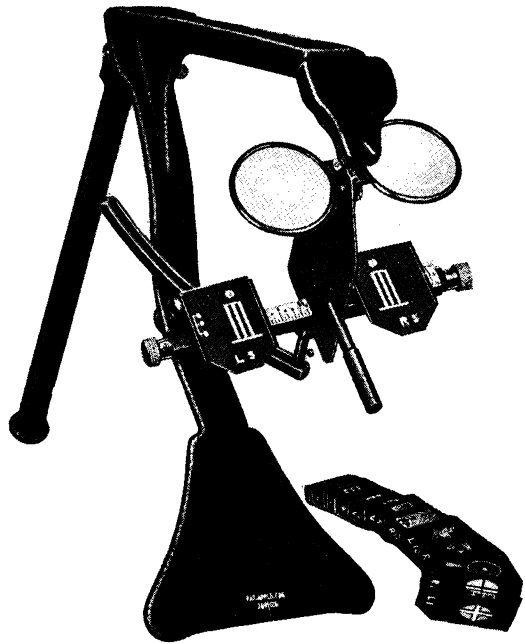

KINETIC STEREOSCOPE

THE recent inclusion of the kinetic principle in orthoptic apparatus has proved to be of distinct value in the treatment of strabismus and heterophoria.

This instrument embodies the principle in a simple form suitable for home exercises under qualified direction. It is provided with meridional as well as rotary movements, and in addition to the training of the fusion faculty, its use aims at:—

1. Improving ocular motility and muscular tone.
2. Developing concomitancy and the maintenance of binocular vision to all parts of the binocular field.
3. Increasing the breadth of fusion.

It is so designed that the stereograms may be adjusted for the several deviations of the eyes, the scales being engraved in degrees for lateral, prism dioptres for vertical, and degrees for torsional deviations. The rotating guide may be fixed for any specified exercise.
