



CUTLER'S IMPLANTATION SET

The new type of plastic Implant for use after enucleation of an eye introduced by Dr. Norman L. Cutler of Wilmington, Delaware, U.S.A. (who has used it in over one hundred cases while he was serving in the Medical Corps of the United States Army), has now been employed by Ophthalmic Surgeons in this Country with success. A need has, therefore, arisen for some standardization of the various devices used, and Theodore Hamblin Ltd., who have had the co-operation of Ophthalmic Surgeons in perfecting these devices, have much pleasure in illustrating them herewith.



A shows the Implant itself. It is made of transparent plastic, is non-absorbable and strong and is made in accordance with Dr. Cutler's measurements.

B shows the button used to tie the sutures through and maintain the depression during healing.

C is an illustration of the retainer shell which is placed inside the lids to keep the Implant centred and prevent prolapse of the conjunctiva.

D is the retainer used after the removal of the button (B) and is similar in structure to the final prothesis (E) with a stud to fit into the depression. All the above (A B C and D) can be sterilised by boiling in distilled water.

E shows the artificial eye (The "Mobil-eye") which posteriorly is made similarly to D but is made to fit the depression after the usual shrinkage of the tissue has taken place.

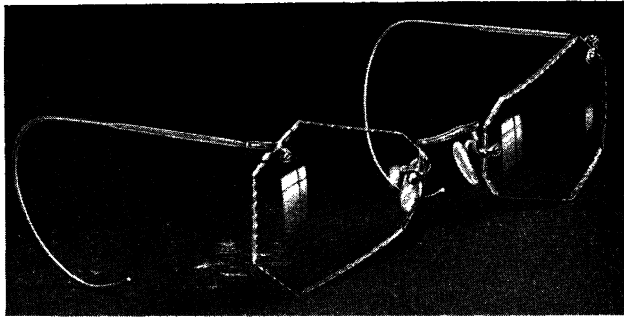

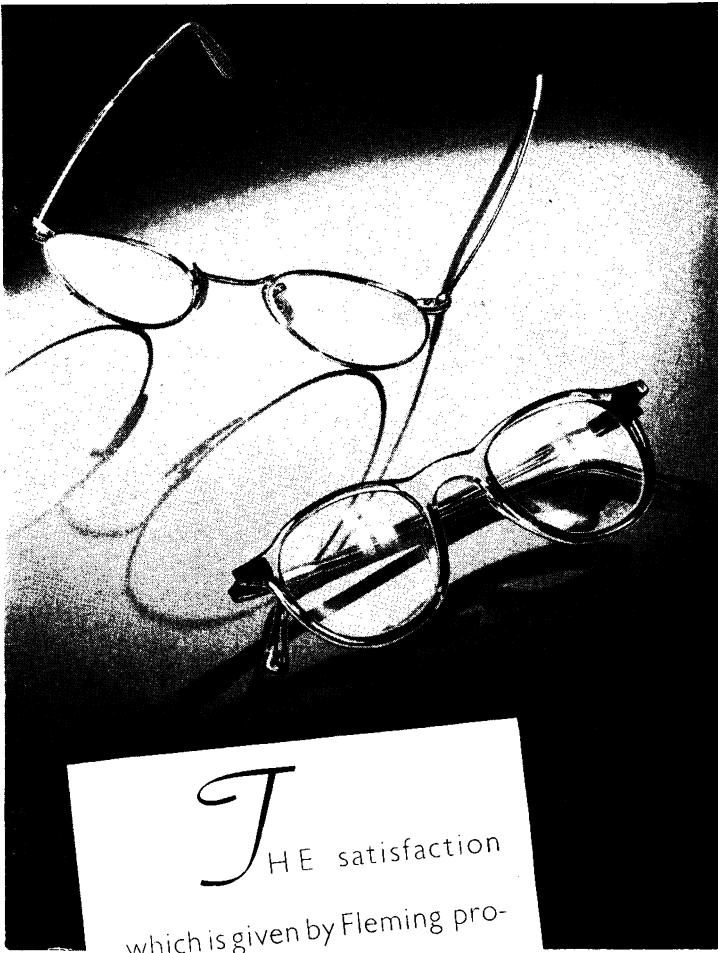
