
HAMBLINS ADJUSTABLE TELESCOPIC OPERATING LOUPE



This magnifying loupe gives two diameters of magnification at a working distance of nine inches. It employs the Galilean principle introduced into this kind of spectacle some years ago by Zeiss. It is strongly made and easily adapted to the individual requirements of interpupillary separation, width of nose, height on face, etc., all of which adjustments should be made before using. The pad supports, though necessarily rigid, are easily manipulated to fit individual noses, while the sides are sufficiently pliable to allow for adjustment to asymetrical faces.
