

POST-OPERATIVE GOGGLE

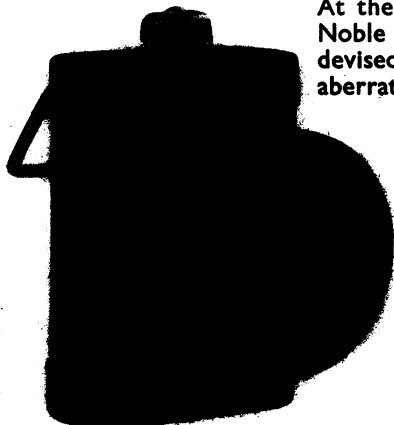

The illustration shows a useful and inexpensive post-operative goggle designed by Mr. Williamson-Noble and described by him in the August, 1950 issue of the British Journal of Ophthalmology. It meets the need for a light, comfortable and inexpensive dark goggle for wear for the complete exclusion of extraneous light after intra-ocular operations. The sides are of fine wire mesh affording adequate ventilation and the fastening is arranged at the side to prevent discomfort to the patient lying in bed.

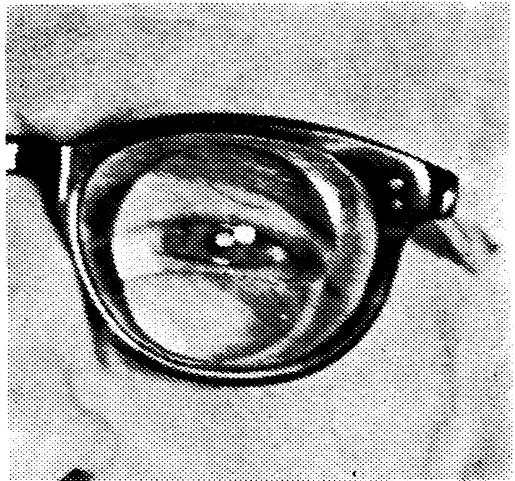
