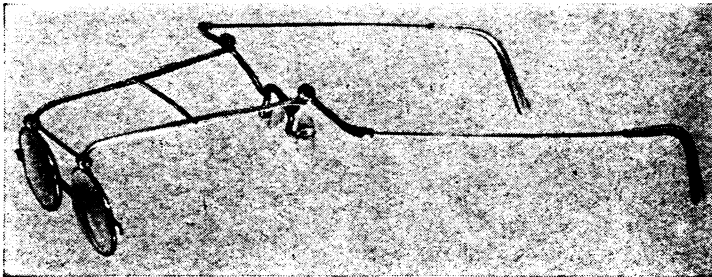
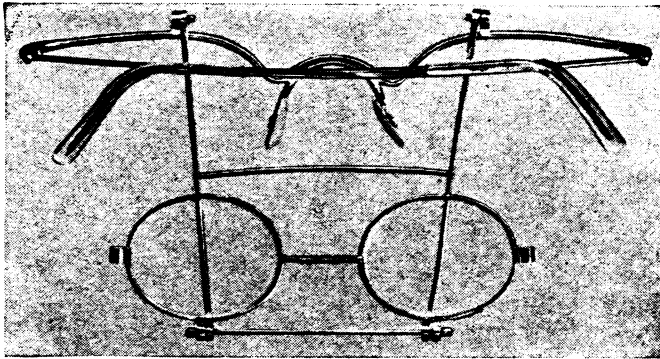

DISPENSING OPTICIANS

STALLARD OPERATING SPECTACLES



These Operating Spectacles, designed by Mr. H. B. Stallard, F.R.C.S., were the subject of an article by him in the *British Journal of Ophthalmology*, October, 1950. They present the following advantages:—

- (1) When the extension carrying the lenses is swung upwards in front of the forehead, there is no obstruction below or to the sides of the operator's field of view.
- (2) The lenses, being placed well in front of the operator's nose and the plane of his mask, never become steamed over.
- (3) The spectacles are very light and comfortable, exerting the minimum of pressure on nose and ears.
- (4) They can be folded flat into a small space.

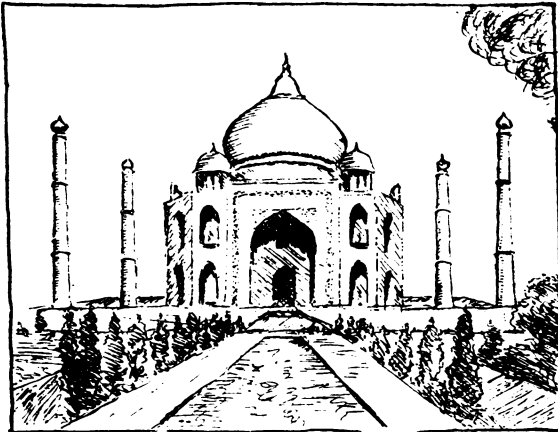
