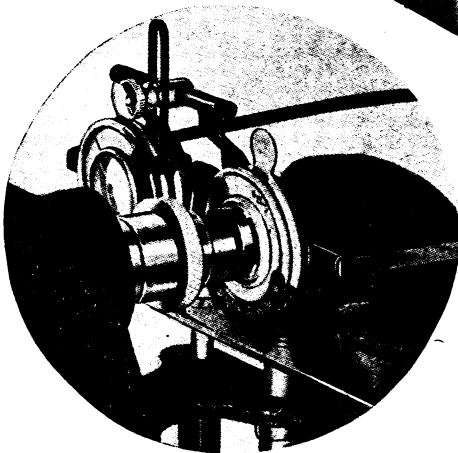
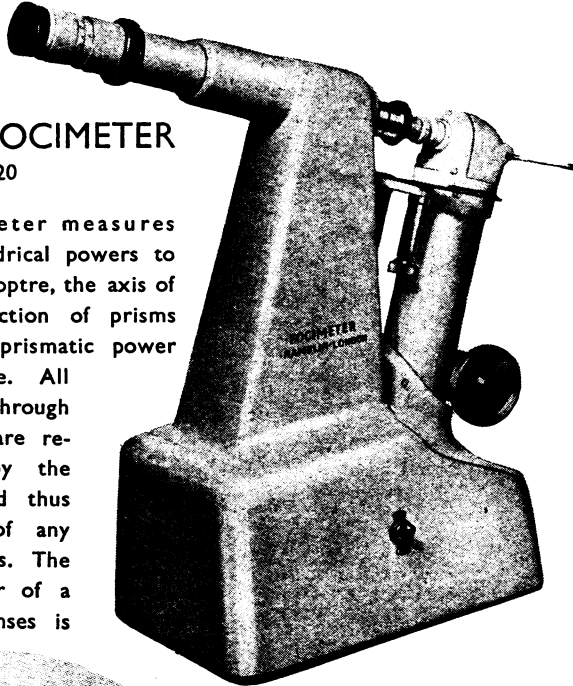

HAMBLINS FOCIMETER

No. 720

Hamblins Focimeter measures spherical and cylindrical powers to within 0.03 of a dioptré, the axis of cylinders and direction of prisms to $1\frac{1}{2}^\circ$, and the prismatic power to $\frac{1}{8}$ th of a dioptré. All readings are seen through the eyepiece and are recorded directly by the optical system, and thus are independent of any wear of moving parts. The exact vertex power of a combination of lenses is



given, no matter how thick or how far apart they may be and irrespective of whether the cylinder is in front of or behind the sphere.¹²

The Surgeon can write his prescription from the recordings of the focimeter confident that it will exactly reproduce the effect of the lenses in the trial frame.

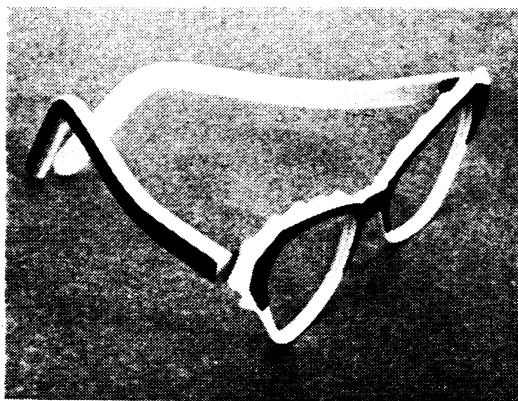
