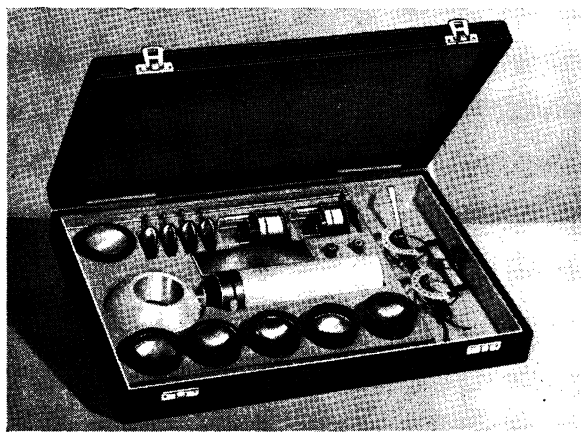


SCHEME

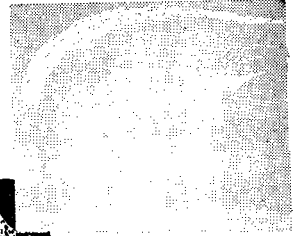
