Sno pilo, supplied as a sterile ophthalmic solution of Pilocarpine Hydrochloride B.P., is presented in a 10ml plastic dropper bottle. There are five strengths available 0.5% w/v, 1.0% w/v, 2.0% w/v, 3.0% w/v and 4.0% w/v.

DOSAGE AND ADMINISTRATION

ADULTS: One or two drops to be instilled into each eye 4 times daily, or as prescribed by the consultant.

CHILDREN: At the discretion of the physician.

CONTRA-INDICATIONS AND WARNINGS ETC.

CONTRA-INDICATIONS. Sno-Pilo is contra-indicated where pupillary constriction is undesirable, e.g. in cases of acute iritis.

SIDE EFFECTS. Ciliary spasm with a temporary reduction of visual acuity occurs. Sensitivity is only rarely observed but if reaction occurs the use of the drops should be discontinued.

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
